1. Please download and review the latest User's Guide:

- 2. Follow the installation instructions in Section 8, System Installation.
- 3. Set up the power control mode as described in Section 7, *System Operation*, and follow the Power-On/Off sequence. The remote extension has to be powered on first, followed by powering on the host computer. Failure to do so may require re-booting of the computer.
- 4. It is recommended to disable PCI Express Power Management. In Windows 7 and 8: Control Panel->Power Options->Change plan settings->Change advanced power settings->PCI Express->Link State Power Management ->Settings: Disable. The instructions for Windows can be downloaded from http://www.adnaco.com/doc/
- 5. Overclocking is not supported. The PCI Express clock frequency must be set to either the default value or 100MHz in the BIOS.
- 6. If you experience any problems, please review Section 10, *Troubleshooting*.
