


How to disable PCIe power management in Windows 7, 8 and 10


The optical transceivers used in the Adnaco *PCI Express over fiber optic expansion systems* do not support PCI Express link power management. Therefore, it is recommended to disable all power management features in the computer. Below are the step-by-step instructions for Windows 7, 8 and 10. For other operating systems, please consult your OS documentation or if you need any assistance please contact the OS vendor.

Windows 7, 8 and 10 instructions:


1. Open Control Panel and click on Power Options



2. For the selected plan click on "Change Plan Settings".



3. Select "Never" for "Put the computer to sleep". Click on "Change advanced power settings"



- 4. Expand PCI Express->Link State Power Management->Settings: and select "OFF".
